#### **SYLLABUS INFO**

- \*\*Recognition level (RL):Some grammar topics are stated as RL to show the teachers that they don't need to spend detailed time on the certain topic.

The teachers are required to spend more time on listening than the other skills.

Readings will not be taught from this skill book unless it is stated on the syllabus.

The task – based portfolio will be given to the students by their main teacher and will be done outside of class. Students will get full points on task-completion. No points will be deducted for mistakes. However, the teachers are required to correct the students' mistakes before letting the students post their videos.
