## NEU INCENTIVE SUPPORT PROGRAM FOR SCIENTIFIC AND

### ARTISTIC ACTIVITIES AND PUBLICATIONS

Near East University provides financial support in two categories which have been explained in detail below, with the aim of increasing the scientific production of the academic staff and creating an incentive in light of the Incentive support program for scientific and artistic activities and publications (ISPSAAP).

The terms and conditions stated bellow are valid from the date of **08.03.2018**.

## 1. FINANCIAL SUPPORT FOR PUBLICATIONS

a) Articles: Article publication support is only given to publications that have an impact factor of 0.25 and above, that are indexed in Web of Science according to the SCHIMAGO journal grouping. After the articles that are published in journals with an impact factor of 0.25 and above and that have been published in the Web of Science with the Near East University address, the financial support is given according to the SCHIMAGO evaluation as; 3000 TL for group Q1, 2500TL for group Q2, 2000 TL for group Q3, 1500 TL for group Q4 and is shared between the authors of the publication who has address as Near East University.

Even though the **abstracts and letters** are indexed in the Web of Science data base, they cannot make use of this financial incentive. **An additional publication incentive is not given to publications that have already made use of the congress incentive before publishing of the full article.** 

In **large projects** with a full paper, that have more than 100 authors, each NEU author is given 200 TL per person.

- b) After the publications with the Near East University address is indexed in Scopus, the financial support is given according to the Scopus Journal, CITESCORE PERCENTILE evaluation as; 1000TL for 76-99 group, 800TL for 51-75 group, 600TL for 26-50 group and 400TL for 0-25 group and is shared between the authors of the publication who has address as Near East University.
- c) **Book:** Book publication support for books that are published by well known international publishers (Pearson, Prentice-Hall, Thomson Reuters, Kluwer, Penguin Random House, Hachette Livre, McGraw-Hill, Holtzbrinck, Scholastic, Wiley, Oxford University Press, Cambridge University Press, EKSMO), for indexes in the WOS book series and books of book chapters that have been indexed in the Book acquisition index will be given at the amounts mentioned below.

Book: 3000 TL Chapter of Book: 1000 TL

Books or chapters of books that have been published by other publishers can be given the amounts below with the decision of the Centre of Excellence Board of Directors.

Book: 500 TL Chapter of Book: 250 TL

- d) APC: for articles that have an impact factor of 0.25 and above and that are in the Web of Science data base, the Article Processing Charge (APC), if it does not exceed the Incentive Support Amount (ISA) can be given in advance and later on deducted from the ISA. If the APC is less than the ISA then the rest of the money will be paid after the article is published.
- e) Other Publications: ISA for other scientific publications that are put into the database of the Web of Science such as case studies that do not come under the heading of an article is calculated as **200 TL**.

# APPLYING FOR FINANCIAL SUPPORT FOR PUBLICATIONS AND ACCEPTANCE CONDITIONS

- 1. The financial support given for the publications is given to full time or part time Near East University workers for publications published in the name of the Near East University after the publications have appeared on the Web of Science database under the following conditions.
- 2. If the publication that is going to be supported has more than one author from the Near East University, then the support given is divided amongst the Near East University authors of the publication.
- 3. Publications that have been done within a scientific coordination of workers under the name of Near East University will also gain support for the academic staff or researchers. The academic staff or researchers applying under this condition, if their email and web address in Google Scholar does not have the extension of neu.edu.tr will be evaluated financially out of a 1000 TL depending on the number of NEU authors.
- 4. If the incentive amount per person is less than 200 TL then this will not be paid.

## 2. FINANCIAL SUPPORT FOR SCIENTIFIC AND ARTISTIC ACTIVITIES

a) Conference/Congress: Financial support, for conferences/congresses that are indexed in the database of the Web of Science at an international level as a full text, is listed below.
1. Oral presentation
2. Poster presentation

c) **Exhibition/Concert:** Artistic activities conducted under the name of Near East University will be given the following financial support **once a year**:

National exhibition/concert: 1000 TL

International exhibition/concert: 2000 TL

# APPLYING FOR FINANCIAL SUPPORT FOR SCIENTIFIC AND ARTISTIC ACTIVITIES AND ACCEPTANCE CONDITIONS

- 1. Only full time academic staff can apply for financial support given to scientific and artistic activities.
- 2. Up to **€800** of financial support can be given for a conference/congress **only once a year.**
- 3. Academic staff who apply for support for a second conference/congress can be given up to €400 upon the decision of the Centre of Excellence Board of Directors to cove the registry costs.
- 4. Lecturers that want to make use of the financial support provided for scientific and artistic activities must apply for this financial support at least **1 month before the activity** that they will be attending.
- 5. Financial support provided for scientific and artistic activities is given to participants who carry the Near East University title for their transportation, accommodation and participation costs.
- 6. Documents that show that the accepted oral presentation/poster, is within the program of the conference of congress and is in the Web of Science database must be provided at the time of the application.
- 7. Document/s that shows the details of the date and place of the exhibition or concert must made available at the time of application.
- 8. After the scientific or artistic activity has finished, the participant must document their participation certificate, receipt of registration, documents that show hotel expenses and boarding pass within at least 15 days.
