

## **Call for Contributions**

All high-quality research contributions describing original and unpublished results of conceptual, constructive, empirical, experimental, or theoretical work in all areas of Water Engineering and Management are cordially invited for the paper/poster presentations at the conference. All participants whose abstracts are accepted are eligible to present at the conference without the necessity to submit a full paper. A maximum of 3 abstracts can be submitted: no participant may be the first author of more than one oral paper and two posters.

# **Conference Proceedings**

All submitted conference papers will be blind peer reviewed by the Scientific Committee. The peer-reviewed conference proceedings are indexed in the International Science Index (ISI), Google Scholar, and other index databases.

## **Special Journal Issues**

Springer journals as a special issue according to their level of contribution. Desalination and Water Treatment Journal is one of the journals where the selected papers will be published in a special issue. The paper selection will be carried out during the peer review process. Submitted papers must not be under consideration by any other journal or publication. The final decision for paper selection will be made jointly based on peer review reports by the Guest Editors and the Editor-in-Chief. The participants who do not attend and present their work at the conference will not be considered for paper publication in any journal.

#### **GUIDELINES**

Sample templates for full paper submission, poster and oral presentation are provided. You are free to use the provided poster template. Please use the full paper template and poster presentation template provided.

**Final Submission:** Submission of abstracts and full papers can be made through the conference web site.

**Presentations:** Standard presentations are scheduled for 15 minutes each. The 15 minutes includes a 10 minute presentation and a 5 minute Q&A session. Each hall will include all tools required for oral presentation.

#### **Poster and Oral Presentation Award**

- 1. The score is given based on: (a) scientific content (50%), (b) presentation to audience (30%), and (c) poster design (20%);
- 2. If presenters do not attend the poster session, their poster will not be considered for the award.
