### **ATTENTION TO ALL STUDENTS**

- In order to enter the **2018-19 Fall Semester Final Exams** all students are required to show their **University ID card** or any other photographed ID and their “**Final Exam Entrance Slip**”. Students without a photographed ID or their entrance slip will NOT be permitted to enter the Final Exams.
- Mobile telephones, smart phones and other smart devices will NOT be permitted into the exam rooms/salons.
- **The 2018-19 Fall Semester Re-Sit Exams will be held between the dates 22-24 January 2019.**
- Students who wish to enter the Re-Sit Exams must fill out their “Re-Sit Exam Application Form” and submit it to the Dean’s Office personally no later than 12:00 January 21 2019. Students who do not make an application will not be permitted to enter the Re-Sit Exams.
- All students who entered the 2018-2019 Academic Year Fall Semester final exams and obtained **FF or FD grades are eligible to enter the Re-Sit Exams for those courses.** Also students who were financially eligible to enter the final exams but could not enter for any particular reason are also eligible to enter the Re-Sit Exams. Also, **only students who have entered the mid-term exam of a course can enter the Re-Sit exam for that course.**
- **The Re-Sit Exams are for the final exams only.** The new end-of-term letter grade will be recalculated with the new score of the Re-Sit Exams.
- **There will be no Re-Sit Exams for courses failed with the letter grade NA (no attendance).** If a student’s GPA for the 2018-19 Fall Semester is below 2.00, then the student will be permitted to enter Re-Sit Exams for courses that they have passed in order to increase their grades and GPA.
