

NEU SCIENTIFIC AND ARTISTIC ACTIVITIES AND PUBLICATIONS SUPPORT PROGRAM (SAAPSP)

Near East University provides financial support in order to augment and encourage the scientific studies, publications and artistic activities of its academic staff in accordance with the Scientific and Artistic Activities and Publications Support Program (SAAPSP) in two categories on the basis of the principles detailed below.

1. FINANCIAL SUPPORT FOR PUBLICATIONS

a) **Article:** Article publication support is provided for the articles published in the journals indexed under the Web of Science or Scopus databases. Financial support is granted after publications appear on the databases as affiliated with Near East University. The following formula is used to calculate the financial support.

$$\mathbf{IP = IC + (200TL \times IF)}$$

*IP = Incentive Payment

* IC = Index Coefficient

SCI, SCI-Expanded, SSCI and AHCI = 2000 TL

ESCI = 1500 TL

SCOPUS = 1500 TL

* IF = Impact Factor

b) **Book:** Book publication support is granted to authors affiliated with Near East University in the following amounts for books or book chapters in book series indexed under the Web of Science or Scopus databases.

Book: 3000 TL

Book Chapter: 1000 TL

c) **APC:** For articles published in journals indexed under the Web of Science or Scopus databases, the Article Processing Charge (APC) fee may be deducted from the calculated IP and be paid to the author as advance payment provided that the amount of the advance payment does not exceed the IP. If the paid advance payment is lower than the IP, the due balance is paid after the article is published.

TERMS OF APPLICATION TO FINANCIAL SUPPORT FOR PUBLICATIONS

1. Financial support for publications is provided for the publications of full-time employees of the Near East University provided that the publications are affiliated with Near East University and indexed under the Web of Science or Scopus database.

2. If more than one author of a single publication is affiliated with Near East University, the financial support is divided by the number of the authors and given to the authors in equal amounts.

3. Part-time academic staff, who affiliate themselves with Near East University as the first or second institution, are also granted article publication support.

4. Financial support is granted to lecturers or researchers affiliated with Near East University in publications made within the framework of scientific cooperation. If the Google Scholar accounts of the applicants, who apply for financial support in such cases, are not linked with a neu.edu.tr e-mail address, then they are granted only 1000 TL.

2. FINANCIAL SUPPORT GRANTED FOR SCIENTIFIC AND ARTISTIC ACTIVITIES

a) **Conference/Congress:** The financial support amount for works presented at conferences/congress and published under the Web of Science or Scopus databases is as follows:

1. Oral Presentation

Turkey: 400€
Other: 800€

2. Poster

Turkey: 300€
Other: 600€

In order to receive financial support for a conference/congress, the applicant's previous year's Publication Support Index (PSI), which is calculated using the following formula, must be equal to or above 0.5.

$$\text{PSI} = \text{IF} \times \frac{\text{Number of Articles}}{\text{Number of Authors}}$$

If IF is below one, IF is considered as one. Academic staff are provided with financial support for Conference/Congress as much as their PSI values. The financial support claimed can be used within 2 years.

b) **Patents:** For patents that originate from the Near East University, financial support is provided as follows:

Patent: 2500 TL

c) **Exhibition/Concert:** Artistic activities where the applicant is affiliated with Near East University are provided with financial support once a year for the following amounts:

National Exhibition/Concert: 1000 TL

International Exhibition/Concert: 2000 TL

TERMS OF FINANCIAL SUPPORT FOR SCIENTIFIC AND ARTISTIC ACTIVITIES

1. Financial support granted for scientific and artistic events is provided to cover transportation, accommodation and event participation costs of participants affiliated with Near East University.

2. Academic staff who are newly employed at the university and therefore have zero PSI value can benefit from the financial support granted for scientific and artistic activities up to two times.

3. Documents showing evidence of acceptance that the paper/poster will be presented at the conference or at the congress, is included in the conference/congress program, and is indexed under the Web of Science or Scopus databases must be presented at the time of application.

4. Participants who have received an official invitation must submit the invitation and/or acceptance letter issued to their name at the time of application.

5. Documents showing the date and venue details of the exhibition or concert events must be presented at the time of application.

6. Once the scientific or artistic activity or event is completed, the applicant must submit a copy of the participation certificate and registration fee receipt/invoice.
